## Comments

- Triclopyr provides effective control of summer melons and is often used as a Glyphosate spike.
- · Do not apply to weeds that are under stress, or not actively growing.
- . Do not apply to wet foliage.
- · Do not clear/burn woody weeds for at least 6 months post treatment.
- Caution: Broadleaf plants are highly susceptible—follow label recommendations to avoid off-target impacts.
- · Remember to follow label restrictions of tank mix partners.
